MINUTE ORDER: On December 16, 2020, Plaintiffs Maria Barraza, et al. filed a complaint for injuries and damages resulting from the Mountain View Fire in El Dorado County Superior Court against Liberty Utilities and Does 1-200. On January 27, 2021, Liberty Utilities removed the action to this Court on diversity grounds. Notice of Removal, ECF No. [1]. Plaintiffs having identified a Doe Defendant, Western Weather, who would destroy diversity, now seek to voluntarily dismiss this action without prejudice so that they may refile in State Court. See Pls.' Mot., ECF No. [9]. Defendant, Liberty Utilities opposed this motion, arguing Western Weathers is a "sham" defendant. See Opp'n, ECF No. [11]. Plaintiff in their reply brief exceeded the Court's 5-page limit on reply memoranda. See Reply, ECF No. [14]; see also Order re Filing Requirements (Order), ECF No. [2]-2. Violations of the Court's standing order require the offending counsel (not the client) to pay \$50.00 per page over the page limit to the Clerk of Court. Order at 1. Moreover, the Court will not consider arguments made past the page limit. Id. Plaintiffs' reply exceeded the Court's page limit by 2 pages. Plaintiffs' counsel must therefore send a check payable to the Clerk for the Eastern District of California for \$100.00 no later than seven days from the date of this order. Having considered the parties' briefing on the matter the Court hereby GRANTS Plaintiffs' motion to dismiss WITHOUT PREJUDICE. In granting Plaintiffs' motion, the Court reaches no decision about whether Western Weather is a proper Defendant. The parties may litigate the issue in State Court, if they choose. IT IS SO ORDERED.
